Teams with a time longer than 150% of the best time after a heat in each class (RNB within RNB), will not be eligible to start in the next heat.

Medal award conditions;

- E S D R A European Champion titles shall be awarded to the best (fastest) teams of each rated class providing at least seven (7) competitors from three countries, are represented in these classes, except in junior and RNB classes where at least three (3) competitors from two countries are represented.
- If there are less entries/countries after the late entry deadline, the class will be combined with the nearest class.
- European Champion titles will be awarded if at least one (1) heat is rune in class.
- Entries for ESDRA member federation members is accepted via the national ESDRA federations. Limited individual number of below specified criteria entries also will be allowed.

Entry criteria:

- Each National Voting Member in good standing with ESDRA is entitled to nominate three (3) open + three (3) RNB teams in each class and unlimited number of entries in Veteran classes, as well as three (3) relay teams. Countries with less than 7 entries are allowed to form mix country relay teams.
- Provisional Member (application form has to be sent to ESDRA along the entry form) is entitled to nominate two 2) open + two (2) RNB team in each class in addition as well as one (1) relay team.
- The Mid-distances classes have no limit to number of entries.
- No special DID is required to enter the event.
- Only Europe country representing mushers are allowed to enter.

Individual entries:

- After 01.10.2020. Individual entries will be allowed with a registration fee of 120 EUR. Any ESDRA member federation will be allowed to block any participant for just cause (local disqualification, debt to federation etc.). Only Europe country participants are allowed to enter.

To be eligible to participate for a country, the participant shall:

- 1) be a citizen of said country;
- 2) be a permanent resident of the said country for at least 24 months;

3) if none of the above, may switch country representation if he/she has received a waiver letter from the previously represented country official sport representing body (or country of citizenship);

4) Dual (or multiple) citizenship owners may choose their country of representation, but cant change it to another for one year or without a waiver letter from that country previously represented.

No participant shall be eligible to participate for more than one nation during the same event.

Additional Rules:

Microchip identification for the dogs is mandatory. All dogs must be listed on the chipping form (one form per driver and per class).

It is strictly forbidden to let dogs run loose at the event site including stake-out and parking areas, for the entire stay at the event site. Refusal to respect this requirement may lead to disqualification.

All participating nations shall appoint one team leader. The team leaders shall be noted on the entry forms. Team leaders shall be present at the team leader meetings. In view of their liaison task between the race organizer and their team members, they should speak English.

Each participant and national team are responsible for the action of all handlers and team leaders.

Participants may inspect the trail only at organizer allowed times, from the weekend before. They can be inspected on bike or scooter, dogs on trail are not allowed during inspections.

Use of private motor vehicles on the trails is not allowed.

REGISTRATION:

All Registrations and payments (including Relay teams) shall be done according to this schedule:

- All registrations shall monitored by the ESDRA Sports Director (<u>sport@esdra.net</u>), ESDRA treasurer (<u>tresurer@esdra.org</u>) and ESDRA President (<u>president@esdra.org</u>)
- The ESDRA Entry forms must be used (special registration system to be launched by 17.08.2020.)
- Entry fees are not refundable (except of the cancelation of the event).

18.09.2020: Ordinary registration

- Ordinary entry fees paid for total number of entries.

30.09.2020: Registration of late entries

- Deadline for additional entry requests. Payment (120% of the regular entry

fee) will be made after confirmation of the request has been given.

01.10.-10.10.2020: Individual registration window.

12.10.2020. – Announcement of the opened classes (Member federations offered to change classes if needed, individual entries to be moved to similar classes

28.10.2020. On site: All participants must submit an ESDRA Competitor Consent Form. Printout will be available for 5 EUR per page.

For participants younger than 18 years old on the first day of the competition an ESDRA Guardian Form must also be submitted.

PARTICIPATION FEE:

Entry fee payment (as stated above) must be made by the National Federations or individuals to the ESDRA account. Invoices will be sent out to Member federations. Individual payment instructions will be available on 01.10.2020.
